New sports facilities delivered for Brisbane City Football Club

The Federal Member for Brisbane, Trevor Evans MP, has today announced that the Federal Government will provide new funding of \$415,478 to upgrade the sports facilities at Brisbane City Football Club located at Spencer Park in Newmarket.

“It’s vitally important that community sports facilities keep pace and meet the growing demand of women players and their families. So it’s great this project includes funding for new change room facilities for female players, female supporters and parents,” said Mr Evans.

The new funding will deliver female specific facilities and parents’ facilities with designated change rooms, cubicle showers, baby facilities, referees room and upgraded toilets, which upgraded facilities will be a huge asset for the local community.

“This funding is a huge boost for the local community and will now make this long planned project by the Brisbane City Football Club a reality”, said Mr Evans.

The funding is part of more than \$950 million the Morrison Government has committed into sport infrastructure to support local and national sporting organisations across the country.

The \$415,478 for the Brisbane City Football Club builds on other projects funded by the Morrison Government in Brisbane including:

- \$1.15 million for improving the environmental health the Brisbane River, bushland and local waterways;
- \$7 million for the National Cricket Campus in Albion;
- \$500,000 for female sports facilities at Grange-Thistle Soccer Club in Grange;
- \$195,402 for the Gingercloud Foundation to expand the modified rugby program;
- \$3.5 million for the refurbishment and extension of the Thomas Dixon Centre in West End;
- \$550,000 for the renewal of local shopping strips in Hamilton, Paddington and Wilston;
- \$500,000 for the Brothers Rugby Club in Crosby Park for facilities upgrades; and
- \$100,000 for the Enoggera Creek Sports Precinct Plan.
